

IMPACT PROVES THAT SMALL STEPS MAKE A BIG DIFFERENCE!

Geared for congregations with under 70 in attendance, IMPACT builds upon the traditions of the past to help you understand your present while preparing for a hopeful future.

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IMPACT guides your church to learn how to thrive in your “tomorrows” instead of hoping to just survive them.

This process includes ongoing learning practices such as strategic goal setting, team ministry, sharing and implementing new directions for your church.

Each session will be facilitated by experienced coaches. By the end of each session, your church will leave with a ministry action plan to take home and begin the work of implementation.

THE DETAILS

In order to qualify as an IMPACT church, you must commit to the following:

1. 20% of your average attendance must commit to attend the nine sessions and work with your team in your local setting.
2. Your teams and pastor must participate in each scheduled session.
3. You are willing to pay \$25 per gathering session (9 x \$25 = \$225).
4. You complete the required paperwork when applying for IMPACT.
5. Two books will be required reading: “The Healthy Small Church” and “Get Their Name.”

THE SESSIONS

Sessions are held on **Saturdays** every other month for 18 months.

Each IMPACT session will be five hours in length. The same format will be used throughout the process:

- Large group spiritual formation and training
- Huddle time with other churches
- Large group sharing and preparing your next steps (Missional Action Plan)
