### Description of Role:

Potential consultants will be individuals who want to see Growing Young principles implemented within the local church. They will strive to see INUMC congregations working to engage youth and young adults as full participants in the life of the church. Consultants will also understand the value of all generations and the necessity of intergenerational ministry. Growing Young Consultants will be the direct line of contact with Bridge-Building Congregations. The caseload for each consultant will be no more than 5 congregations.

### Responsibilities Include:

Attending Fuller Youth Institute Training in Indianapolis

Assisting with Webinars hosted by Fuller Youth Institute

Coaching Calls with assigned congregations

Listening projects related to assigned congregations

Support of local church ministry experiments

On-site visits with assigned congregations

Speaking to congregations to promote the Growing Young Bridge-Building Congregations opportunity

Meet with other consultants for team-centered project management and collaborative development

### Benefits Include:

Training from Fuller Youth Institute to become a Growing Young Consultant – Lifetime Certification

Stipend with equivalent rate to other Fuller Youth Institute Consultants

Paid travel expenses related to consulting

### Additional Details:

Consultants must be INUMC trained in Child and Youth protection and pass a background check

Consultants will be a representative for the INUMC and covenant to conference policies

Anticipated work hours – 10 per month

Time Frame – Summer 2024 to Spring 2026
