5 The United Methodist Memorial Home was established in 1907 with a gift of money and 200 acres of
6 farmland located in Warren, Indiana from William and Ruth Chopson. Mr. and Mrs. Chopson requested
7 the United Methodist Church use the gift to establish a debt-free retirement home. The first resident building
8 with 37 rooms was completed in 1910 where the current Heritage Pointe of Warren campus currently stands.
9 Over the years, the United Methodist Memorial Home has undertaken numerous remodeling and expansion
10 projects in Warren in addition to opening campuses in Huntington and Fort Wayne.

12 Our Board of Trustees is made up of 11 trustees—six United Methodist ministers and five lay people—who
13 volunteer their time and talents on our Board of Trustees. Our current officers and Board members are Rev.
14 Toni L. Carmer, President; Rev. J. Steven Burris, Vice President; Mr. Michael L. Summers, Treasurer; Mrs.
15 Sherry L. Fulbright, Secretary; Mr. Jon M. Brown; Rev. Steven K. Conner; Mrs. Marlene A. Fenstermacher;
